- Attach letters of recommendation from one teacher, one coach/athletic director and one counselor or administrator.
- Must attend an accredited 2 or 4-year college or university.
- Financial need is not a consideration for selection.
- Deadline: March 31, 2024 in the DDHS College & Career Center by 3:00 PM

Applicants will be judged by a scholarship committee and they reserve the right to withhold the scholarship if none of the applicants meets the criteria.
